 Excellent lunch spot. The food drops off in the evening as the beer crowd arrives. tag as resto lunch plateau beer

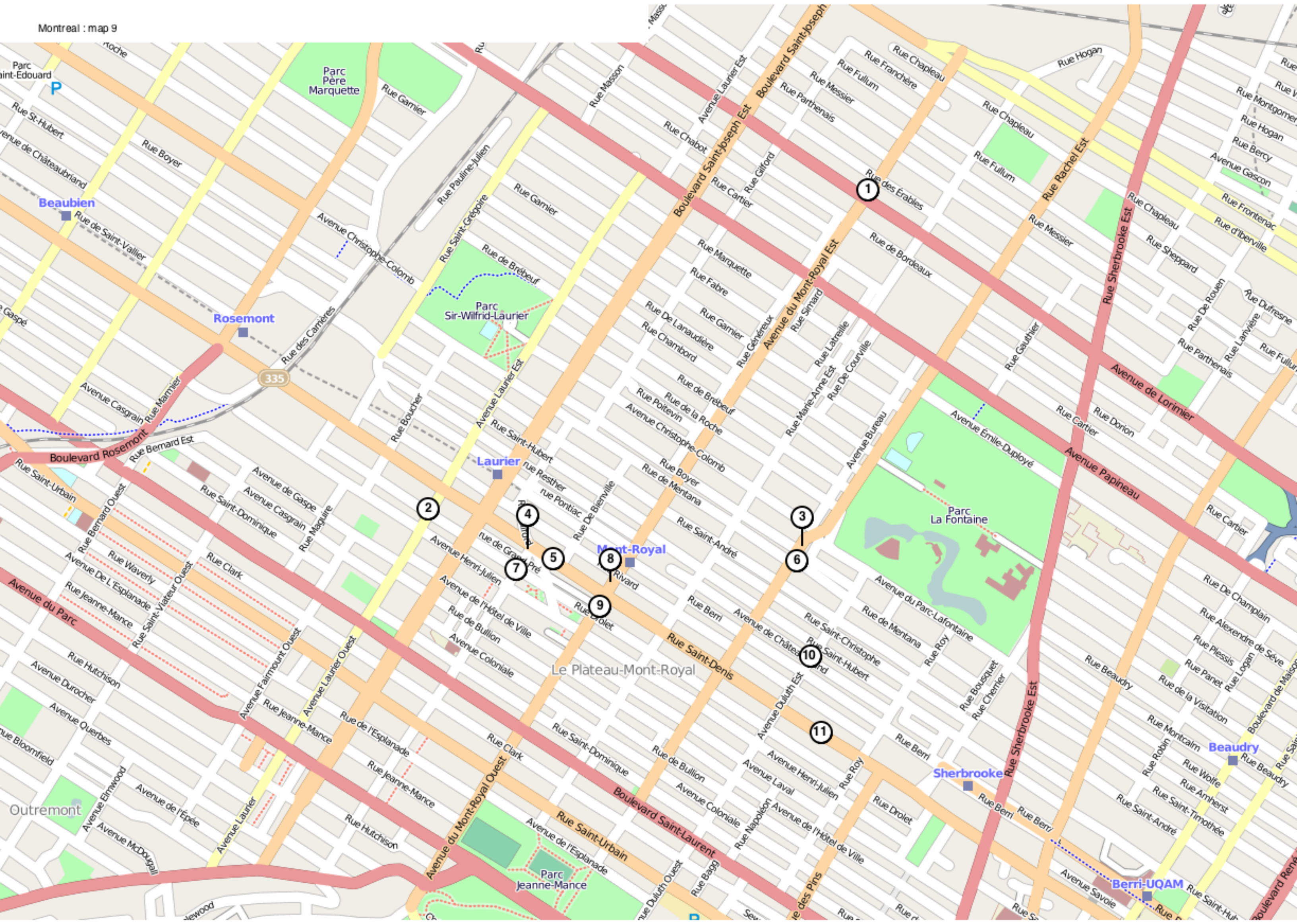
